Matthew 28:6


When Mary Magdalene and the other women came to the sepulchre after the death of our Lord, they were greeted by the angel of the Lord. Oh, what glorious words he spoke to them! Today, my heart is impacted anew by their magnitude. Listen as his voice declares, "He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay." This proclamation captures our spirit and soul. We read it again and again. Joyously, we hear, "He is Risen!" We receive the glad invitation, "Come see." My, I love that! Jesus, our Lord, was the Lamb of God slain from the foundation of the world.² This plan of God to rescue man through the death of His Son was effected after three days of suffering in our place. Sin was "put away" for all who would believe He was raised from the dead and would confess Him as their Lord.⁴

Many years have elapsed since then, but out heart is ever the same. In our spirit, we recognize the instructions of the Scripture to go into all the world to teach all nations.
