## He Is Risen, As He Said.

Matthew 28:6

When Mary Magdalene and the other women came to the sepulchre after the death of our Lord, they were greeted by the angel of the Lord. Oh, what glorious words he spoke to them! Today, my heart is impacted anew by their magnitude. Listen as his voice declares, "*He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.*"<sup>1</sup> This proclamation captures our spirit and soul. We read it again and again. Joyously, we hear, "He is Risen!" We receive the glad invitation, "Come see." My, I love that! It is the cry of God to the world. "Come see!"
